Our suppliers, such as IGO3D, 3DJake, and producers like Esun, Polymaker, Fiberlogy, Bambulab, and Extrudr, are carefully selected for their reliability, quality of materials, and their alignment with our ethical standards.

To maintain the integrity of our supply chain, we conduct a thorough vetting process for all suppliers. This process includes:
